1. General description

The 74LVC1G11 provides a single 3-input AND gate.

The input can be driven from either 3.3 V or 5 V devices. This feature allows the use of this device in a mixed 3.3 V and 5 V environment.

Schmitt-trigger action at all inputs makes the circuit highly tolerant to slower input rise and fall time.

This device is fully specified for partial power-down applications using I_{OFF} .

The I_{OFF} circuitry disables the output, preventing the damaging backflow current through the device when it is powered down.

2. Features and benefits

- Wide supply voltage range from 1.65 V to 5.5 V
- 5 V tolerant inputs for interfacing with 5 V logic
- High noise immunity
- Complies with JEDEC standard:

 - ◆ JESD8-B/JESD36 (2.7 V to 3.6 V)

 - ◆ MM JESD22-A115-A exceeds 200 V
- CMOS low power consumption
- Latch-up performance exceeds 250 mA
- Direct interface with TTL levels
- Multiple package options
- Specified from -40 °C to $+85$ °C and -40 °C to $+125$ °C




Fig 1. Logic symbol




Fig 2. IEC logic symbol







Fig 3. Logic diagram





Fig 7. The input (A, B, C) to output (Y) propagation delays




Fig 9. Package outline SOT363 (SC-88)




Fig 10. Package outline SOT457 (SC-74)


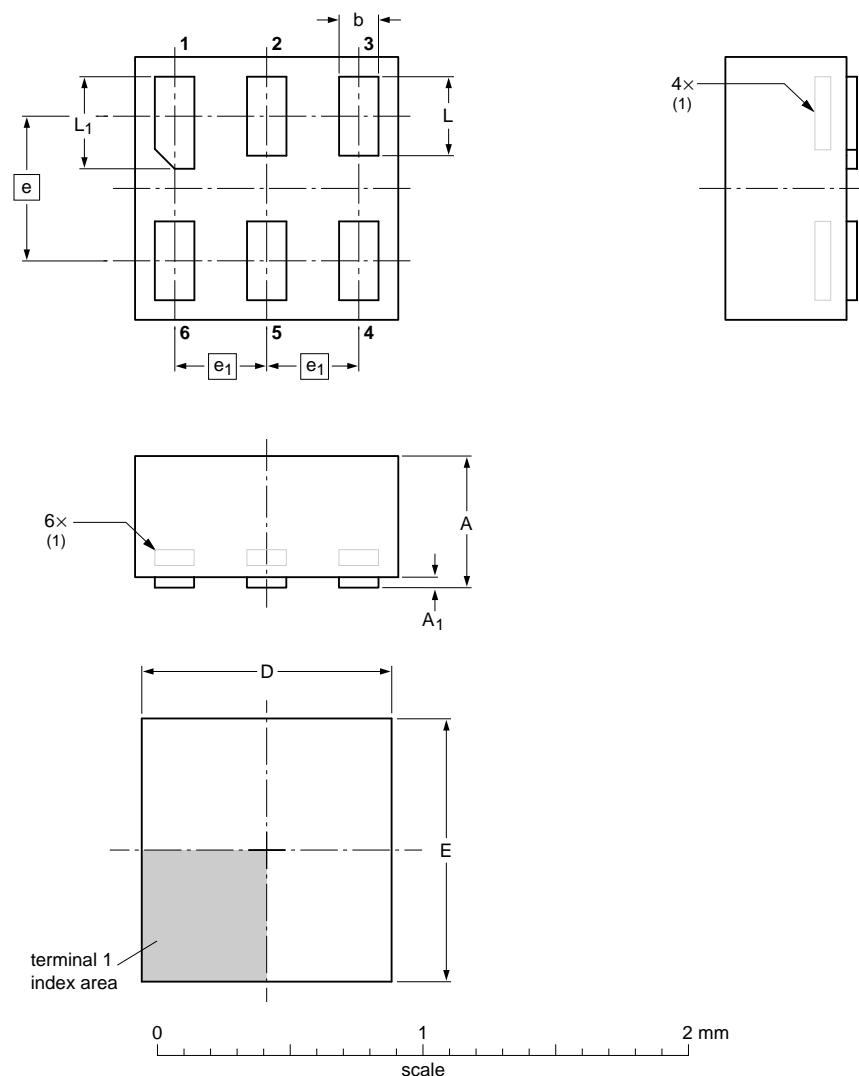


Fig 11. Package outline SOT886 (XSON6)



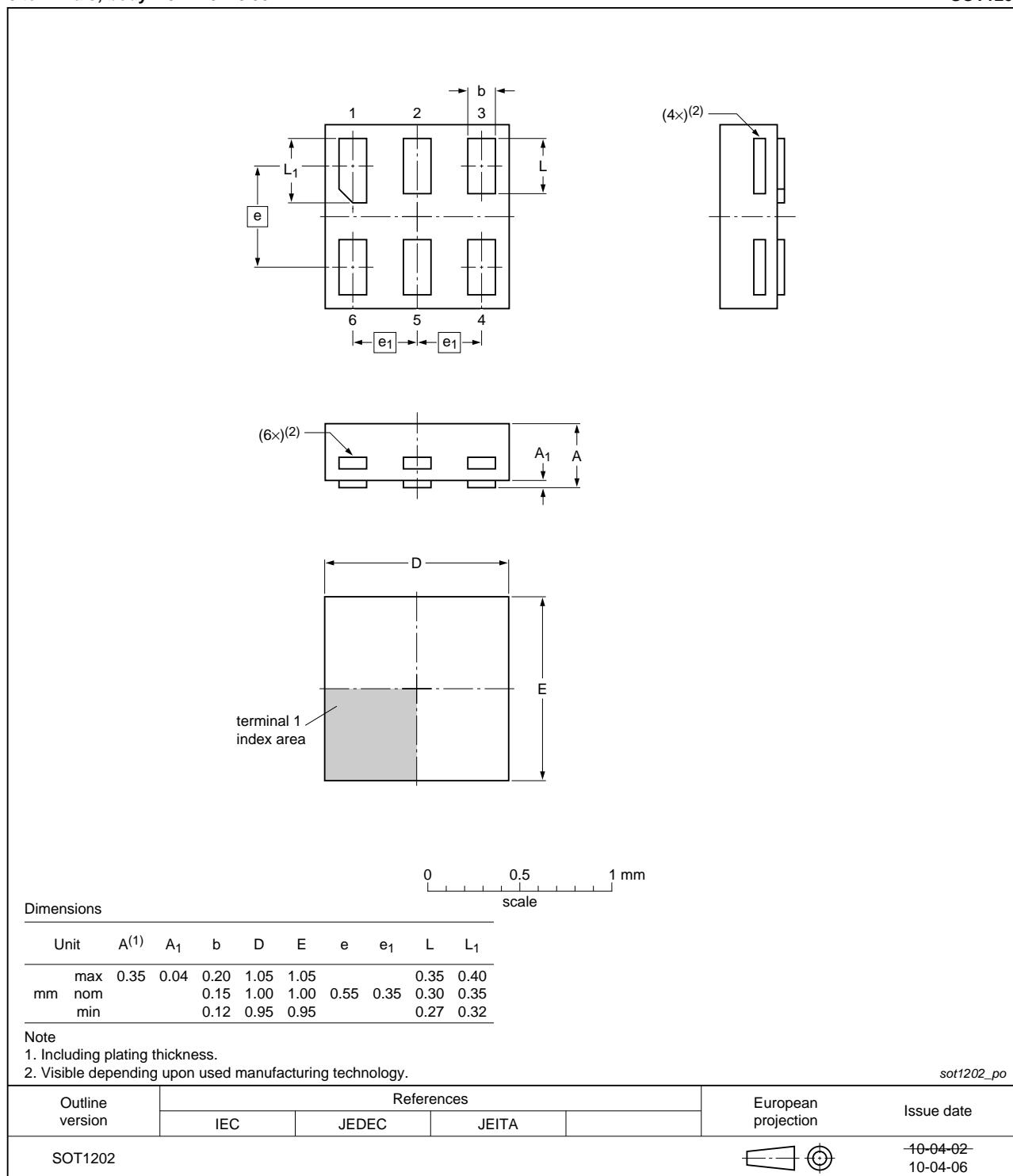


Fig 14. Package outline SOT1202 (XSON6)
