

QUADRANT ASSIGNMENTS FOR PIN 1 ORIENTATION IN TAPE

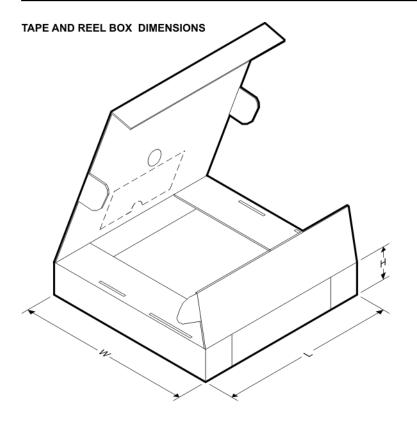
