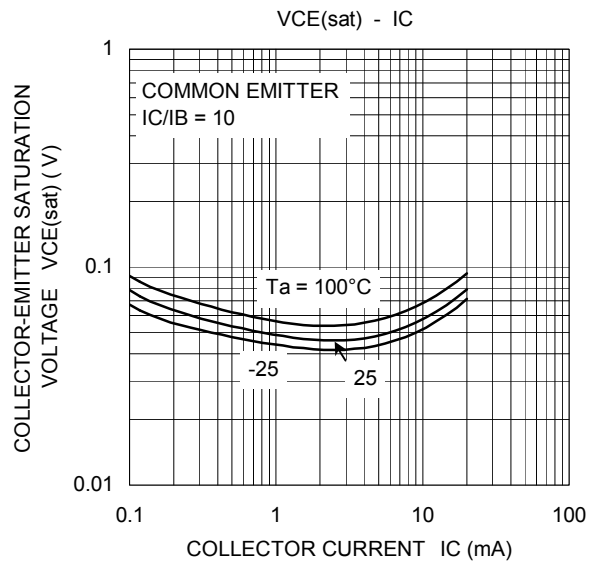
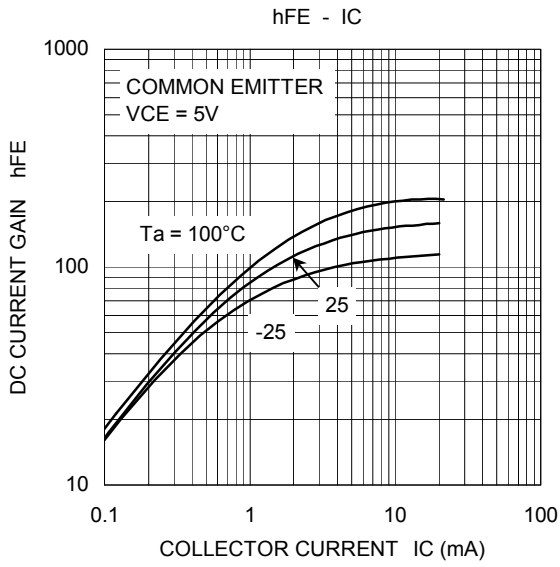
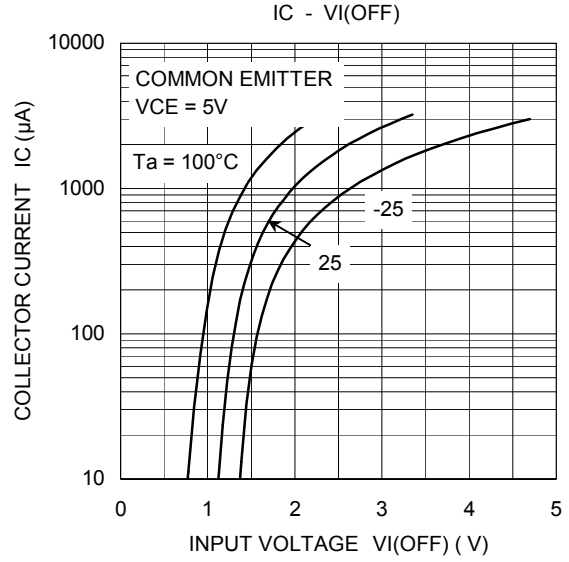
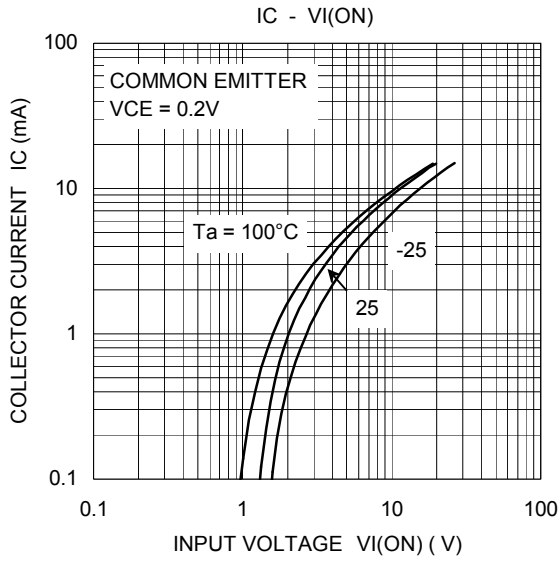
Land Pattern Example (unit: mm)
